Aislynn liked cutting right away. She was hooked. Aislynn made sure she didn't miss a summer with grandma! Aislynn had the opportunity to show "Boogie", and more recently, Something Powerful and Docs Stylish Acre.

Every year, Aislynn's Grandpa Dave asked her when she was ready to show Docs Stylish Acre. She decided this year. And what a year! She showed him at Kearney, NE in the spring. Her fist score on the horse was a 70. And it's been up from there!

Off to Mandan, ND where she marked her first 74 and 73 aboard the sorrel gelding. NCHA Days in Dillon Aislynn won the circuit award and right at \$700 in the \$2000 LR. Aislynn cashed paychecks at the Snowy Mountain Spectacular in Lewistown, MT along with checks in Batesville, Mississippi.
